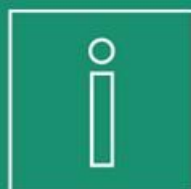

To access the Forum venue, you need to receive a badge and pass a [PCR test](#). **An accreditation badge is invalid without a negative PCR test result.**

Plan your route in good time so that you arrive at the venue at least 1-1.5 hours before the start of the event of your interest.

Unaccredited transport and taxis will not be granted access to the venue.

During the event, traffic on Peterburgskoye Shosse will be restricted between Pulkovskoye Shosse and Vitebsky Prospekt.

Free shuttles will run from the [transport hubs](#) to the Forum venue and back. Shuttles will also run between the Forum venue and recommended hotels, Pulkovo Airport, Moskovsky Rail Terminal and Accreditation Centre 1.

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ENTRY TO RUSSIA FOR FOREIGN PARTICIPANTS

DOCUMENTS FOR CROSSING THE BORDER

To avoid encountering any problems when crossing the border, all foreign participants arriving from abroad are required to bring the following documents with them:

Participants are **not required** to present a PCR test result for entry to Russia.

VISA VALIDITY PERIODS

After submitting all the required documents, Forum participants can obtain a short-term, single-entry Russian visa **for the period from 18 July to 6 August** at foreign consular offices of the Russian Federation on the day of their application.

HOW TO APPLY FOR A VISA?

1. Generate an invitation for foreign arrivals

Go to the 'My events – Russia–Africa Economic and Humanitarian Forum – Event dashboard – Visa support' tab of the [Roscongress personal account](#). Your personal information will be automatically uploaded from the Roscongress personal account to the document. You can manually add the city and country where you will be applying for your visa.

Download and print the invitation for foreign arrivals. Provide your Russian consular office with the invitation for foreign arrivals and the other required visa documents.

If you have found any errors in your personal data in the application for participation, you can contact a Roscongress Foundation specialist to make changes to the personal data.

2. Submit an application at a consular office

To receive a visa for entry into Russia, individuals in possession of an invitation must apply at the relevant foreign consular office of the Russian Federation. Information about the location of Russian consular offices can be found on the website of the [Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Russian Federation](#).

We recommend that participants apply at their Russian consular office in good time, and at least 2 (two) weeks before their departure.

Participants are advised not to apply for entry visas at intermediary visa centres or travel agencies, which are not authorized to issue official visas.

GETTING TO ST. PETERSBURG

BY AIR

Pulkovo Airport (LED) is St. Petersburg's only airport that serves scheduled domestic and international flights. During the Forum, regular free shuttle buses will run from the airport to the recommended hotels and to the Forum venue.

In advance of and during the Forum, [PCR testing centres](#) will be available at central terminal, lounge for officials and delegations, A-Group Business Aviation Centre, Pulkovo 3 Business Aviation Centre, and Pulkovo VIP lounge. Information and services point will be staffed at the central terminal to provide Forum participants with all the necessary information.

CURRENCY EXCHANGE AT THE AIRPORT

There is a **currency exchange point** in cash in the flights registration area of Pulkovo Airport (central terminal, 3rd floor). List of currencies: EUR, USD, CHF, CNY, TRY.

Opening hours: around the clock (technical breaks are possible).

You can ask a question, book a currency, and also clarify the time of technical breaks by calling +7 (495) 796 9355 and +7 (495) 139 4305.

ORDERING A TAXI AT THE AIRPORT

To order a taxi, we recommend using Yandex Go. You can pay for the trip with a bank card in the Yandex Go app.

There are official Yandex Go counters at Pulkovo Airport. For domestic flights, order a taxi in baggage claim. For international flights, order one right after baggage claim. To use the service, you need to contact the taxi registration desk employee and clarify the service tariff. The counters are open from 08:00 to 20:00.

ARRIVING AT PULKOVO AIRPORT BY PRIVATE JET

If a participant or group of participants is planning to arrive in the Russian Federation by private aircraft, but there are no direct flights between the country of departure and Russia at the time, it is necessary to **request permission in writing to land the private jet and send it to the Roscongress Foundation.**

Regardless of whether there are direct flights between the departure country and Russia, all participants arriving in Russia by private jet must submit a request to land the aircraft at Pulkovo Airport.

FLIGHTS TO MOSCOW

Should you be unable to travel directly between your point of departure and St. Petersburg, we advise flying via one of Moscow's airports. Moscow's three main airports – Vnukovo, Domodedovo, and Sheremetyevo – handle more than 30 flights daily to St. Petersburg. The flight time is approximately 90 minutes.

Direct flights to Moscow operate from Algeria, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Bahrain, Belarus, China, Cuba, Egypt, Ethiopia, India, Iran, Israel, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Qatar, Serbia, Sri Lanka, Tajikistan, Thailand, Turkey, Turkmenistan, the UAE and Uzbekistan. Alternatively, you may contact airlines directly.

To move from any of the airports to Moscow and back, you can use the services of Aeroexpress trains:

TRANSIT VIA FOREIGN AIRPORTS

Should you be unable to travel directly between your point of departure and an airport in Russia, we advise flying via a country offering flights to Russia.

At present, flights are available through transit points in Armenia, Egypt, India, China, Kazakhstan, the United Arab Emirates, Turkey, and Uzbekistan.

BY RAIL

MOSCOW – ST. PETERSBURG

RUSSIAN RAILWAYS INFORMATION CENTRE

Sapsan high-speed trains depart from Leningradsky and Kursky Rail Terminals in Moscow, and arrive at Moskovsky Rail Terminal in St. Petersburg. Seventeen trains run along the route daily, with the journey time ranging from 3.5 to 4 hours.

FORUM VENUE

The business programme events of the Russia–Africa Economic and Humanitarian Forum will take place at the ExpoForum Convention and Exhibition Centre. ([64/1, Peterburgskoye Shosse, St. Petersburg](#)).

Plan your route to the ExpoForum Convention and Exhibition Centre in good time.

Please note: unaccredited transport and taxis will not be granted access to the venue.

During the event, traffic on Peterburgskoye Shosse will be restricted between Pulkovskoye Shosse and Vitebsky Prospekt.

Transport hubs will be organized for participants who are arriving with unaccredited transport. Free shuttles will run from the transport hubs to the Forum venue and back. Shuttles will also run between the Forum venue and recommended hotels, Pulkovo Airport, Moskovsky Rail Terminal and Accreditation Centre 1.

ACCESS TO THE FORUM VENUE

Plan your route in good time so that you arrive at the venue at least 1-1.5 hours before the start of the event of your interest.

While planning a route to the Forum venue, please note that the travel time is 30 minutes only in the period from 05:00 am to 07:00 am. Later on, the ride time to the ExpoForum Convention and Exhibition Centre may increase up to 1-1.5 hours.

During the Forum, a high traffic load is expected on the main transport arteries of St. Petersburg: Nevsky prospekt, Liteiny prospekt, Vitebsky prospekt, Moskovsky prospekt, Pulkovskoye Shosse and Peterburgskoye Shosse.



Traffic on Peterburgskoye Shosse will be restricted between Pulkovskoye Shosse and Vitebsky Prospekt. The entry of vehicles into restricted access areas is possible with transport passes only.

Participants will not be able to arrive at the venue by unaccredited transport and taxi.

The travel time is also affected by the vehicles security check procedures at Checkpoint 1 at the entry to the Forum venue. During the inspection, the driver and all passengers in the car present accreditation badges.

HOW TO ENTER THE FORUM VENUE?

01.

Receive a badge

Get your badge in advance at Accreditation Centre 1 ([Outlet Village Pulkovo, 60/1, Pulkovskoye shosse](#)). In order to receive a badge as smoothly as possible, please check whether all necessary documents and data have been provided in the Roscongress personal account. 02.

Take a PCR test

The badge is activated automatically once you receive a negative PCR test. To access the Forum venue after 27 July, you must pass a PCR test one day prior to your first visit to the venue, **starting from 07:00 Moscow time on 26 July**. If you need to visit the Forum venue before the start of the business programme events, you can take the test one day prior to your first visit to the venue starting from 08:00 Moscow time on 24 July. **Please note:** the Forum venue will be closed until 16:00 on 25 July. Plan your route to the venue

Unaccredited transport and taxis will only get to the [transport hub](#) on Pulkovskoye Shosse. From the transport hub, all participants use shuttle buses to get to the Forum venue. During the Events, free shuttles will run between the Forum venue and transport hubs / Accreditation Centre 1 / suggested hotels for Forum participants / Pulkovo Airport and Moskovsky Rail Terminal.

Leave items prohibited at the Forum venue at the accommodation

Upon arrival, each participant will have to go through the access control procedure. The participant may be asked to turn on your phone or laptop and show other equipment that you brought to the venue.

To avoid any inconveniences with access to the Forum events, we recommend that participants leave items that are prohibited at the Forum venue at their hotels.

There should be no large closed containers, bags, liquids in containers of more than 500 ml, or any other [items prohibited at the Forum venue](#) in the vehicle.

Don't forget your passport

Please don't forget to bring along an identifying document (passport) to the venue. You must present your passport at the checkpoints and keep it with you while you are at the Forum venue.

BADGE COLLECTION



The Forum venue may only be accessed with an accreditation badge.

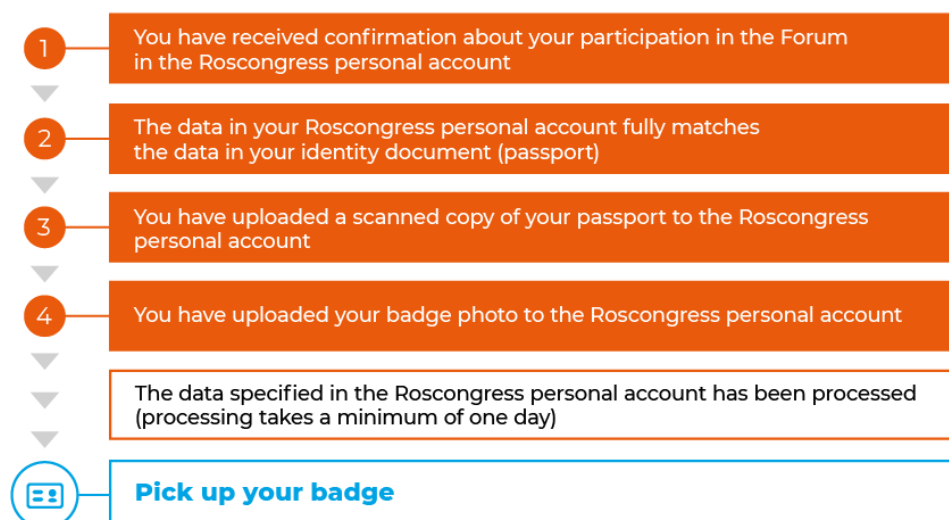
The badge is personalized and may not be transferred to third parties. Participants should keep their badges and identity documents with them at all times while at the Russia–Africa Economic and Humanitarian Forum venue.

The badge is activated automatically by a negative PCR test result.

If your accreditation badge is lost or damaged, please go to the Help Desk or any accreditation stand immediately.

WHAT DO I NEED TO CHECK BEFORE PICKING UP MY BADGE?

Before collecting their badges, participants are advised to ensure the following in the 'Event Dashboard' section:



If there have been any changes to a participant's ID since the application was completed, their personal data needs to be updated in the [Roscongress personal account](#) accordingly. If changes need to be made to fields that cannot be edited, a participant should inform Roscongress Foundation specialist whose contacts are indicated in the Roscongress personal account.

Before issuing a badge, an accreditation point attendant will make sure that the data specified in the Roscongress personal account corresponds to the ID document. In the event of any discrepancies, it will not be possible to issue a badge the same day.

HOW DO I KNOW WHEN MY BADGE IS READY?

You can check whether your badge is ready using one of the following methods:

- Check whether you have received a notification by mail about the badge being ready for pick up
- Check if there is a 'ready' mark in your [Roscongress personal account](#)
- Call the Forum information centre at: +7 (812) 406 7471
- Call the specialist who is responsible for registering you at the Forum

HOW DO I PICK UP MY BADGE?

A participant badge can be collected **in person** upon presentation of:

- ID (info must match that in the Roscongress personal account);
- the original copy of the personal data processing consent form.

Alternatively, badges may be collected **by an authorized representative** under power of attorney providing the following:

- authorized person's passport;
- original of standard power of attorney;
- list of participants (attached to the power of attorney);
- copies of participants' passports;
- originals of personal data consent forms.

A personal data consent form, a power of attorney form, and an example of how to complete it are available for download from the '[Badge collection](#)' section of the Forum website.

We kindly ask that you collect your accreditation badge **in advance** at the accreditation point.

On 26–28 July, shuttles running between Pulkovo Airport / Moskovsky Rail Terminal and recommended hotels for participants, make a stop at the Accreditation Centre 1 on request. We recommend, if possible, to get a badge right away upon arrival in St. Petersburg.

PCR TESTING AND BADGE ACTIVATION

All Forum participants must take a PCR test for COVID-19 **at a dedicated Forum testing centre**.



TESTING FOR ACCESS TO THE FORUM VENUE AFTER 27 JULY

- To access the Forum venue after 27 July, you must pass a PCR test one day prior to your first visit to the venue **starting from 07:00 Moscow time on 26 July**.
- A single PCR test submitted **after 07:00 Moscow time on 26 July** is enough to attend all Forum events, including the plenary session.

Access to the plenary session is by special invitation and activated [special pass](#) only. An invitation will be sent by email.

TESTING FOR ACCESS TO THE FORUM VENUE ON 25–26 JULY

- If you need to visit the Forum venue before the start of the business programme events, you can take the test one day prior to your first visit to the venue starting from 08:00 Moscow time on 24 July.
Please note: the Forum venue will be closed until 16:00 on 25 July.
- If you are invited to the plenary session, you need to pass a second test a day before the plenary session **starting from 07:00 Moscow time on 26 July**.

Results will be provided within 24 hours, LAMP method test results – 1.5 hours.

There is no need to pay for regular PCR testing. Off-site testing and LAMP testing require payment.

HOW TO PASS A TEST?

- 01.** Provide information about COVID-19 immunity in the [Roscongress personal account](#)
- 02.** Find your ID in the [Roscongress personal account](#) and bear it in mind
- 03.** Sign up for PCR testing in the [Roscongress personal account](#)
- 04.** Present your Forum participant ID and take a PCR test

DATA REQUIRED FOR TESTING

1. Information about your immunity to COVID-19

In order to be admitted for PCR testing, all participants must provide information about their immunity to COVID-19 in the [Roscongress personal account](#):

- information about COVID-19 vaccination status;
- information about previous coronavirus infection (COVID-19) status;
- information about the presence or absence of COVID-19 antibodies;
- information about permanent residence and temporary addresses in St. Petersburg during the events.

2. Forum participant ID

The ID is a participant's identification number in the Roscongress personal account. You can view your ID:

- on the badge (if it has already been received);
- in the 'Personal data' section of the Roscongress personal account next to the participant photo.

If a test is not associated with a participant ID, it will not be possible to send the test results to the Accreditation Centre in order to activate the badge to attend the event.

3. Medical treatment consent form

For participants planning to take a PCR test in Moscow, you must print, fill in and sign a medical treatment consent form before visiting the testing centre and bring it with you. Medical treatment consent form is available in the ['Documents required for testing'](#) section of the Forum website.

WHERE TO GET TESTED?

Testing will be carried out at the Forum's dedicated testing centres, which are provided by Rospotrebnadzor in Moscow and St. Petersburg.

The results will be automatically uploaded to the Forum information system.

The results of tests taken at other laboratories will NOT be accepted.

BOOKING A TEST

PCR testing at dedicated Forum testing centres is strictly by appointment only.

Sign up for PCR testing in the [Roscongress personal account](#).

Please note: in order to book a PCR testing you must fill in all the required fields of the questionnaire in the 'Data on immunity to COVID-19' section. Required fields are marked with an asterisk.

To book a PCR testing, go to the 'My events' section of the [Roscongress personal account](#) and choose 'Russia–Africa Economic and Humanitarian Forum', then open the 'Event dashboard – COVID-19 – PCR test booking' tab, choose the most convenient testing centre from the list and select a time slot.

Bookings for off-site tests cannot be made via the Roscongress personal account.

Testing applications are accepted daily from 09:00 to 18:00 (Moscow time).

LAMP TESTING

Forum participants and media representatives may test for COVID-19 by the loop-mediated isothermal amplification (LAMP) method. LAMP testing must be paid for. Results are available within 1.5 hours.

To get tested, sign up using your [Roscongress personal account](#). In the list of testing centres, select those with the [LAMP](#) prefix.

You can pay for LAMP testing following a link in the [Roscongress personal account](#), by legal entity testing contract (+7 (985) 846 0012, +7 (985) 886 1444, rus-africa@fcgie.ru), or at the testing centre using a QR code.

At the testing centre, please inform the staff that you plan to be tested using the loop-mediated isothermal amplification method.

TEST RESULTS

Lab results will be provided within 24 hours and indicated in the 'COVID-19 – Test results' section of the [Roscongress personal account](#).


If you don't get the test result, you can find out information by calling the Forum information centre at +7 (812) 406 7471 or your Roscongress Foundation specialist, whose contacts are available in the Roscongress personal account.

ACCESS TO THE PLENARY SESSION

Access to the plenary session is by special invitation and activated special pass only. An invitation will be sent by email. If you are invited to the plenary session on 27 July, you need to receive a special pass (access card) in addition to your badge.

WHERE TO GET A SPECIAL PASS?

Receive your special pass at the special pass distribution stand:

 26 July, 09:00–20:00

The special pass can be received only upon producing the identity document (passport) that is listed in the Roscongress personal account.

The special pass cannot be issued if the data in your Roscongress personal account is incorrect.

To collect a special pass for another participant, **the authorized participant must present** the following:

- the authorized person's passport;
- a list of participants obtaining special passes (in case the authorized person collects special passes for several participants);
- **originals** of participants' identity documents that are listed in the Roscongress personal account;
- an original standard power of attorney.

You can download the power of attorney form in the 'Access to the plenary session' section of the Forum website.

On 27 July, badges for venue access are activated according to the results of a [PCR test](#). To access the plenary session, testing must be taken **no later than one day prior** to this event starting **07:00 on 26 July** Moscow time.

You do not need to take a PCR test to collect your badge or a special pass. You can collect them and then take a PCR test or do it in the reverse order.

TRANSPORT

TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS

The movement of unaccredited vehicles will be limited on the territory adjacent to ExpoForum during the Forum. In addition, there may be temporary restrictions on the access of vehicles to the following sites:

- Pulkovo Airport;
- Moskovsky Rail Terminal;
- recommended hotels for participants;
- event venues of the cultural and sports entertainment programmes.

Only vehicles with transport passes may enter restricted areas.

Plan your route in good time so that you arrive at the venue at least 1-1.5 hours before the start of the event of your interest.

UNACCREDITED TRANSPORT

Participants will not be able to get to the venue using unaccredited vehicles and taxis. During the event, traffic on Peterburgskoye Shosse in the section from Pulkovskoye Shosse to Vitebsky Prospekt will be restricted.

Unaccredited vehicles and taxis will have access only to transport hubs on Pulkovskoye Shosse. From the transport hub, all participants use shuttle buses to get to the Forum venue. During the Events, free shuttles will run between the Forum venue and transport hubs / Accreditation Centre 1 / suggested hotels for Forum participants and the places of arrival and departure of participants – Pulkovo Airport and Moscow Railway Station.

FREE SHUTTLE BUSES FOR PARTICIPANTS

Shuttles are the main way to access the Forum venue.

Book for the shuttle in the [Roscongress personal account](#) beforehand. Registration is essential to ensure everyone enjoys a comfortable ride.

An accreditation badge, negative PCR test result, and shuttle seat booking are all required to get on the shuttle.

26 JULY

On 26 July, free shuttles will run along the following routes at regular intervals:

- between Pulkovo Airport and recommended hotels*
- between Moskovsky Rail Terminal and recommended hotels*

** The shuttle can stop at Accreditation Centre 1 (Outlet Village Pulkovo) upon request.*

27–28 JULY

On 27–28 July, free shuttles will run along the following routes at regular intervals:

- between the Forum venue and transport hubs A1, A2, A3, A4, B, C
- between the Forum venue and Accreditation Centre 1
- between the Forum venue and recommended hotels
- between Pulkovo Airport and recommended hotels*
- between Moskovsky Rail Terminal and recommended hotels*
- between Pulkovo Airport and the Forum venue*
- between Moskovsky Rail Terminal and the Forum venue*.

** The shuttle can stop at Accreditation Centre 1 (Outlet Village Pulkovo) upon request.*

29 JULY

On 29 July, free shuttles will run along the following routes at regular intervals:

- between Pulkovo Airport and recommended hotels
- between Moskovsky Rail Terminal and recommended hotels

Uniformed transport coordinators with identification signs will be on duty at shuttle bus departure points.

In addition, the Russia–Africa Economic and Humanitarian Forum will become a platform for the Media Forum, the Meeting of University Rectors, and the Roundtable attended by Russian and African Supreme Audit Institutions. On the sidelines of the Forum, participants can visit the unique sessions of the Creative Business Forum and Healthy Society Forum; a session dedicated to cooperation between Russian and African government bodies and enterprises related to the precious metals industry, and much more. An intensive youth programme is planned at the Forum as well.

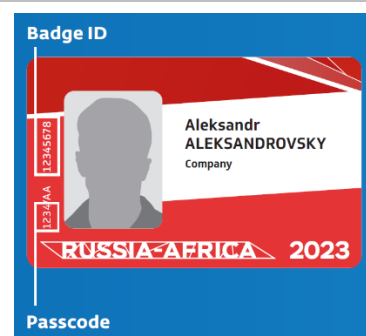

CURRENCY AND BANK CARD TRANSACTIONS

CURRENCY EXCHANGE

Please note the following currency exchange restrictions in the Russian Federation:

- Identification is required for transactions exceeding RUB 40,000. Participants must present their passports for such exchanges;
- There is NO exchanging non-cash currency for RUB cash using Mastercard or Visa bank cards issued outside of Russia. It is also not possible to withdraw RUB cash from these cards.

For the latest exchange rates, please see the Central Bank of the Russian Federation website: cbr.ru.

BANK CARDS

Given the existing restrictions on the use of foreign bank cards in Russia, we recommend that you carry cash with you for the entire duration of the Forum.

Cards of the Mir and UnionPay payment systems work in Russia without restrictions in any currency. Participants are encouraged to apply for a card or bring with them an existing card of any of these payment systems, if possible.

DRAWBRIDGE SCHEDULE

There are drawbridges across the main waterways of St. Petersburg. If driving, bear in mind that at night it is not easy to get from one side of the river to the other because of the drawbridges. To avoid being stuck in one part of the city or having to use bypasses, please take note of the drawbridge schedule.

WEATHER IN ST. PETERSBURG

St. Petersburg has a humid coastal climate. Rainy weather is expected during the Forum, air temperature can vary from +19 to +22 °C. Due to the city's geographic position and its proximity to the Baltic Sea an extreme change of weather is possible. **We recommend Forum guests to keep warm clothing and an umbrella to hand.**

In the pavilions and parking areas, **a barrier-free environment has been created for people with reduced mobility**. The facility is equipped with ramps and lifts that allow unimpeded access throughout the venue.
